Dear supporter of immigrant and civil rights,

On May 1st 2007 thousands of immigrants and their allies will come out in support of immigrant rights just like last year. In 2006, our mobilization stopped the Sensenbrenner bill HR4437 that would have criminalized millions of workers in the country. **This year we must go back to the streets so we can put an end to the raids and deportations and to continue to fight for legalization and worker rights for all!** We have a chance to win a fair and pro-immigrant comprehensive immigration reform but only if we go back to the streets!

We need your support to raise the funds necessary to cover the expenses of the upcoming **May 1st Immigrant and Worker's Rights March & Family Unity at Julliard Park** and to help with funding as we continue our efforts well after May 1st. *We are all volunteers and all donations will be used for funding of the upcoming May 1st action and other important projects of CIRSC in support of immigrant rights.*

The Committee for Immigrant Rights of Sonoma County is a participating member organization of a broader **"May 1st National Coalition for Worker and Immigrant Rights"** that intends to build a National Movement that will continue to advocate for immigrant-worker rights beyond May 1st. More than 100 major national organizations and coalitions on both sides of the Mexico/US border are involved.
